# Join AmeriCorps volunteers Saturday

The public is invited to work alongside a team of AmeriCorps volunteers at the White Point Nature Education Center on Saturday.

The AmeriCorps volunteers are continuing a 9-week project to assist the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy restoring habitat and replanting coastal sage scrub. The work will benefit several species, including the California gnatcatcher and cactus wren, a press release said.

The volunteers, who hail from eight different states, are working at White Point Nature Education Center

in San Pedro and performing trail restoration at Abalone Cove Reserve in Rancho Palos Verdes.

This is the third AmeriCorps team to work with the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy, the release said.

The public is invited to join the volunteers on Saturday from 9 a.m. to noon during the White Point Community Day to help remove tumbleweeds and beautify the native plant demonstration area.
