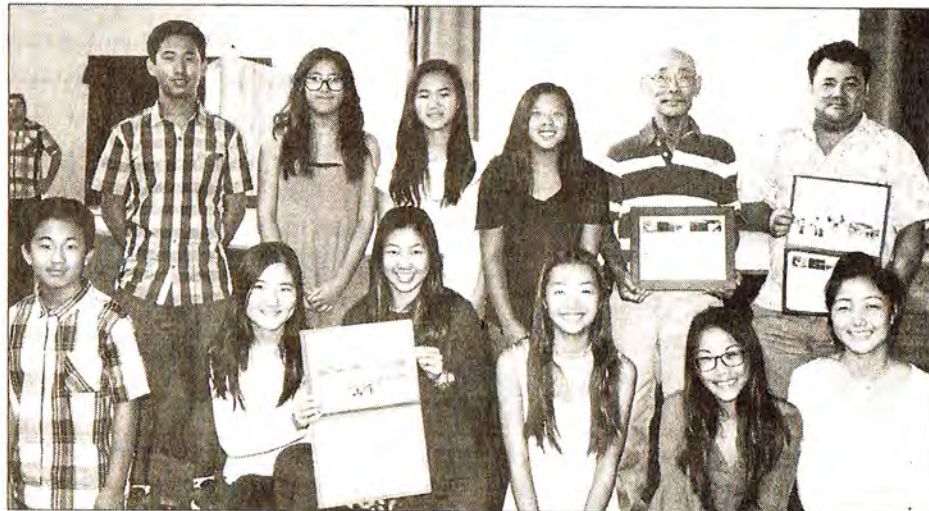


Boeing employees assist beautifying preserve
