Assembly member Bonnie Lowenthal honored Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy Stewardship Associate Adriene Bosler as one of 30 women honored at the 2nd Annual 30 Under 30 Event as part of “Make A Difference Day.” The event honors outstanding women who are working to improve our community.

“Our future depends on these young women, and on young women and men just like them,” said Lowenthal, D-Long Beach. *“It’s absolutely critical that we acknowledge their efforts and help them on their way.”*

Adrienne Bosler is the Stewardship Associate for the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy. Adriene coordinates the outdoor volunteer programs including weekend volunteer work days, the Team Leaders program, the KEEPERS citizen-based monitoring program, and the Trail Skills training program. She also works on GIS mapping, monitoring, and reporting for stewardship activities. Adrienne was awarded a 2012 Audubon TogetherGreen Fellowship to help lead conservation actions that will help shape a healthier environmental future.
