Nature Walks - Get outdoors and into nature for enjoyable, easy walks through the Nature Preserves. Naturalists will guide you through beautifully restored habitat to discover the unique variety of birds, mammals, reptiles and insects that make these natural areas their home. Since its founding in 1988, the Conservancy has successfully preserved 1,600 acres of natural land with over forty miles of trails on the Palos Verdes Peninsula. The spectacular views and precious habitat now saved forever not only contribute to the quality of human life, but provide valuable wildlife corridors for plants and animals. In addition, the Conservancy provides public activities that connect people to nature including an annual film festival and a school-based Junior Naturalist program that reaches over 24 schools each year. Two nature centers, George F Canyon in Rolling Hills Estates and White Point in San Pedro, offer interactive exhibits, demonstration gardens, guided walks, volunteer days, educational presentations, plant sales and many other activities for all ages.
