This year, some 40 local volunteers, friends and family will spend the morning with the Palos Verdes Peninsula Land Conservancy from 9am to 12 noon working on the 64-acre Abalone Cove Reserve. Volunteers will help remove invasive plants from along the coastline, allowing native habitat and wildlife to grow. Their work will also help to prevent invasive seedlings from spreading further throughout the Preserve
