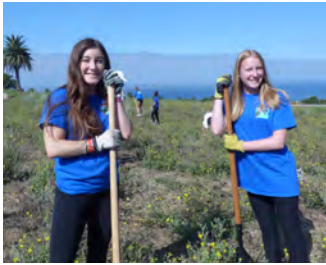
White Point Nature Preserve
