## Program Description

The program consists of four in-class lessons with information on native plants and animals, and Native-American culture. The program culminates with a field trip to local open space where children are led on an interactive nature walk to use their in-class training.

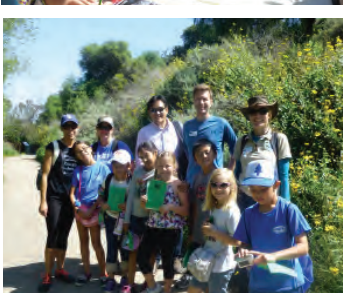
